Applications submitted without course outlines, even if there is no change in course content from previous submissions, will not be considered. Include all scheduled dates and contact information that, if approved for CMPs, will be posted to the Board's website.

CMP applications will not be accepted for oh&s activities that are less than six (6) hours. Activities that are less than six hours may be submitted for CMP consideration only if the cumulative total meets or exceeds six hours (eg. Six one-hour oh&s sessions could be submitted for CMP consideration).
